

Double Digit War Card Game

Set Up:

- Get a deck of cards
- Remove the 10s, Jacks, Queens, and Kings from the deck
- Shuffle the deck and pass out all the cards so each player has half the deck

How to Play:

- To start, each player will turn over the top two cards in their stack and lay them side by side. The first card is how many tens you have and the second card is how many ones you have. Then, each player will identify what their two digit number is. For example, one player in this photo has 37 and the other has 88. The player with the highest number gets to take all four cards and put it in their discard pile.
- If the players' cards are equal, leave them on the table and turn over the next two cards in the stacks and lay them on top of the first pair of cards. The player who has the highest number of their top two cards will take all eight of the cards.



How to Win:

- After all the cards have been played, each player will count the cards in their discard pile. The player with the most cards wins. You can choose to keep playing by playing with your discard pile until one player has all the cards.
