100's Chart Battleship Game

Set up:


- I. Print out the 100's chart (see next page). Each player needs their own 100's chart. If you cannot print the chart, you can make your own!
- 2. Each player will need something to write with, and several game pieces. You could use small pieces of paper, or pieces of cereal for your game pieces! These will be used to mark your ship on your 100's chart.
- 3. Find an old shoe box top, file folder, or book to use as a divider to put between you and the other player. Example:

How to play:

- I. Each player puts a group of 2, 3, and 4 game pieces on numbers either horizontally or vertically. For example, you could put your game markers on numbers 52, 53, 54, or 21, 31, 41. See example above.
- 2. Players take turns calling out numbers from the 100's chart. If your opponent calls a number that is covered by your game piece, say "hit". If the number is not covered say "miss."
- 3. To keep track of the numbers being called, it may be helpful to use your writing tool to make an "x" on numbers that were a "miss", and color in the box for the numbers that were a "hit."

How to win:

The first player to destroy all 3 of your opponent's battleships, wins!
